Local events that you could join in with ...

Thu 10 May 8.30 am ... Ascension Day

8.30 a.m. Prayer Breakfast in St Mary's, Kinnerley

7.30 p.m. Holy Communion in St John's Maesbrook

Fri 11 May 3.00 p.m. Prayer Walk around Maesbury

This is a gentle walk of about 1.5 miles, is all on the level and should be accessible to nearly everyone. Meet at Maesbury Church.

Tue 15 May

7.30 p.m. 'Thy Kingdom Come' Praise & Prayer Evening with coffee & cake, in Knockin Assembly Rooms

A gathering of people from many different churches, organised by the local 'Filling Station'.

Wed 16 May

9.00 a.m. Morning Prayer in St John's, Maesbrook

2.00 p.m. Prayer Walk up to Rodney's Pillar

This is an energetic walk of about 4 miles involving a climb of around 300 metres and it may not be accessible to everyone. Please contact Brian if you would like to take part in this walk.

Fri 18 May

3.00 p.m. Prayer Walk on the Cliffe

This is walk of around 2 miles involving a gentle climb of around 50 metres and should be accessible to most people. Meet at the Pine Car Park in Nesscliffe Country Park ... this is the larger car park at the top of the bendy narrow lane that goes up from Hopton.
